Another reminder: The committee need members to put their names down for matches in plenty of time so that they can be selected the week before the match.

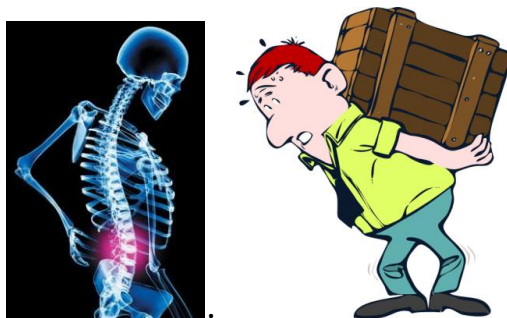
New If someone puts down for an away match and later puts down for the reverse home match, they will have preference in selection. **Please write (PA) next to your name.**

- 08/07/16: Ladies Harrow & District home to Preston Park. Won by Mary Warner, Anne Snell and Maureen Alder who are through to the next round.

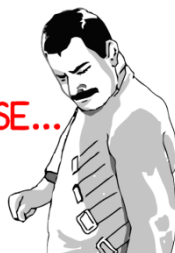
