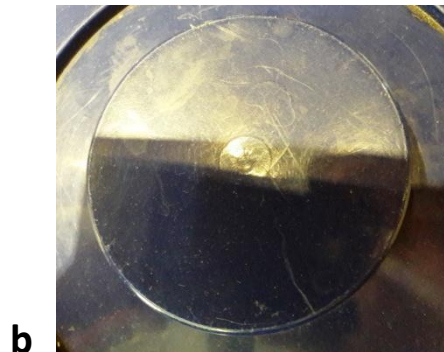

Congratulations to Magan Kanjia who beat Nigel Ward of Uxbridge 21-15 so is through to the quarter final.

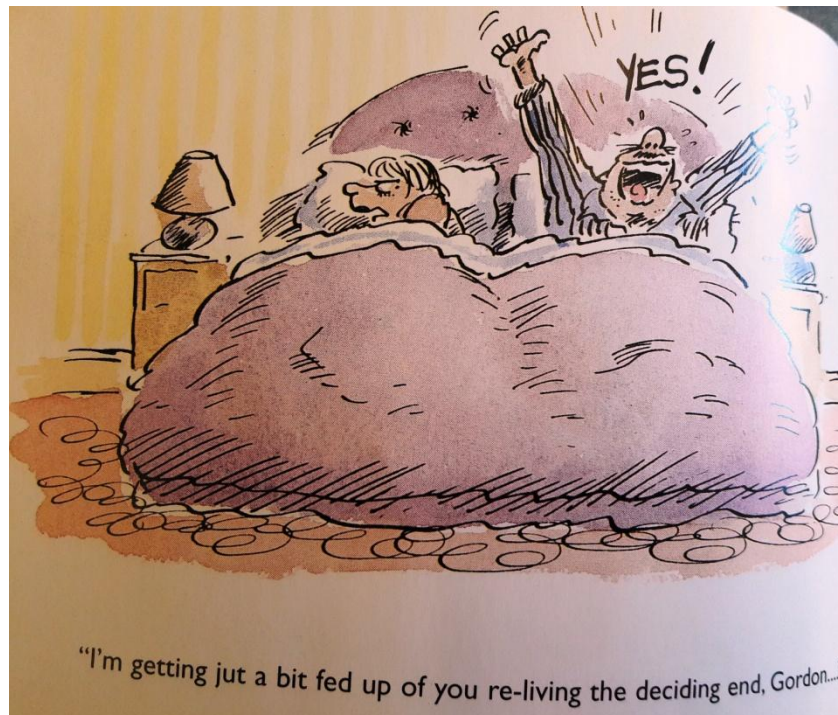
Congratulations to Phil Bayley, Peter Lee, Andrew Georgiou and Magan Kanjia who won their H&D 4s.
